

## Environmental Statement

We take our environmental responsibility seriously, and Lawrence & Beavan has planted trees with The Woodland Trust as an acknowledgement of the paper usage of our sector. We specify paper for print which is made from fibres sourced from sustainably managed forests, and we discuss with our suppliers issues such as the inclusion of chlorine in its manufacture, and paper mill policies on effluent control, filtration and chemical re-use.

We supply pdf proofs for client checking throughout the process as this is generally the most convenient and accurate system, as well as being environmentally sound. We have noticed a major reduction in the amount of paper used for laser proofs since introducing this system, and we use pdfs as a matter of course unless specifically requested for paper proofs by our clients.

We also supply many of our final high res files to our printers via our own ftp site, thereby saving transport costs, time and emissions.

We reuse materials within the studio wherever possible, and have greatly reduced the use of office paper by the introduction of pdfs for estimating and in-house documentation.

Wherever possible we donate old equipment to charities who will reuse them. If nobody wants the materials, we dispose of them via the council recycling centres.

Our in-house health and safety policies include ensuring that the environment within our office is optimised for the benefit of all our staff and visitors.
